THE MISSION

The driving force of Gospel of God Ministries is to proclaim the Gospel in the cities of America, with partner churches and volunteer, until faith becomes action, allowing the Holy Spirit to transform people. We have the unwavering belief that God is willing and able to build a (universal) church that will impact the nations for His glory through the proclamation of the Gospels and making disciples to do the same. If this continues to happen, there will be an evangelist inside of every healthy church in America.

THE VISION

Gospel of God Ministries proclaims and teaches the Gospel in cities all over the world, alongside partner churches and volunteers until faith becomes action. We do this in three ways:



SHAPE

We shape by training believers how to share their faith and how to defend it. We want to ignite people to put the Gospel into action. (Matthew 28:19); to help pastors encourage and equip new believers for evangelistic efforts by training them with our five evangelism curriculums (2 Timothy 4:5); to give nominal Christians courage and a platform to share their faith at local events (Romans 1:16); and to find evangelists and disciple them to perform their God-given roles through our two-year internship (Ephesians 4:11).



The harvest is great but the laborers are few (Luke 10:2). A low percentage of Christians share their faith on a regular basis. Bill Bright from Campus Crusade says it's as low as 3%. GGM takes believers out to share their faith in Jesus. We focus on abortion clinics, sporting events, street festivals, and college campuses.



We support the local church by working with believers that are committed to the local church.

The Apostle Peter said that we should be ready to give a reason for the hope we have (1 Peter 3:15). And Galatians 1:9 claims that false gospels are being taught and they must be exposed and condemned. False religions, humanism, and cults are saturating our culture, catering to the rebellious human heart. Truth must be spoken to awaken people from their rebellious slumber.



THE UNREACHED

As a general statistic (and example of our nation's state), the U.S. pop-ulation in 2011 was over 311 Million. The membership of the seven major Protestant denominations in the U.S was just shy of 42 Million. So, this gives us a general number of over 269 Million unreached people. But if every member in the seven denominations were to share their faith with about 7 people, the entire U.S. population would hear the Gospel. We want to raise an evangelist up in every healthy church in America.

JOE TOY



I was raised in a home that attended church but without evidence of salvation for either my parents or siblings.



Turning to the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, I repented and placed my faith in Jesus that night in my room. My view of life is simple – Jesus died and came out of the grave for me, so I have to live for Him.

1. Just Getting Started

If you have never shared your faith we have a training that will help you overcome the hurdle of fear and give you the tools you need to be Biblical in how you present the Gospel.

2. Dealing With False Beliefs & Cults

If you have shared your faith and just get hung up on what to say to those who are of other beliefs and cults we have one just for you that will cover the six major false beliefs and cults.

3. I Have A Question

Maybe you are getting several objections from your friends on why they don't believe in Christianity. We have training that deals with the top five common objection and we will show how all other objections have their origin in the top five.

4. Dealing With Present Day Holocaust

This training will help you think through how to end abortion in your city by taking the Gospel to your local abortion mill. We will also discuss a strategic way you can help end abortion once and for all.

5. Go Stand And Speak

This training is geared for those men who want to go and break the sound barrier by learning how to Open Air Preach. We will focus on ten major lessons that any new Open Air Preacher must master in order to have longevity in their calling.



COACHING

Anyone who wants to go through our coaching track is welcome to attend our coaching sessions via conference call. We offer coaching two times a year once in the spring and fall. A two year internship is coming soon!

By the end of 2021 we will have a full online degree program for Open Air Preachers. This will be a four semester degree that will equip the Open Air Preacher for a lifelong ministry of evangelism and supporting the local church.

INTO THE HARVEST

This is a book that has application questions after each chapter. This book takes the scriptures and my encounters in the harvest field and brings them together to motivate you to trust the Lord of the harvest again as you are being faithful to share a true clear Gospel to our lost world.
