### **Harvest Field Report**

200,000 people have heard the gospel

- 175 GGM teams have gone out into the world
  - 4 missionaries were encouraged in the Middle East to remain faithful to the gospel message
- 18 evangelists were trained to go out and herald the gospel in their local cities
- 40 lay people were equipped to go out and share the gospel in their communities
- 25 babies were saved from murder in the womb, by GGM or various GGM partners. Pray that these mothers would not turn back to the horror of murder
- **80,000** tracts given out proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ
  - 75 Bibles were given out
  - 4 people have made a profession to follow Jesus. Pray that they would bear fruit proving that they are born again
  - **560** gospel conversations were had with unbelievers

All in all, there were more than 60 hours of preaching, more than 10,000 tracts handed out, and a case of Bibles given away to those who visited the fair.

We preached the Good News, that Christ, who was crucified and buried and rose again,

defeated death, so that they might turn today from their sins and believe in Him alone for salvation and eternal life.

ho am I to go out to a local abortion clinic and call out to these men and women to love their children? What do I have to offer to these moms and dads? Am I making any impact at all in the lives of these people? I must admit I have asked myself these questions at least a thousand times or more. These are real questions that enter the minds of gospelminded missionaries each time they leave the comforts of their homes to engage men and women that are hell-bent on taking the lives of their children through abortion.



Ministering at an abortion clinic is challenging and difficult. The spiritual battle that rages in front of a killing center is palpable. Many times I have watched people act in ways that can only be described as demonic. I have been threatened with physical violence more times than I care to count. Curse words and middle fingers fly through the air with regularity. The police are called again and again. Passersby honk their horns and scream obscenities at us for daring to engage with these women and for begging them not to kill their precious babies. In the summer, the scorching heat burns our

skin and causes us to sweat relentlessly; while in the winter, our toes and fingers go numb from standing in the freezing weather for hours on end. Ready to sign up?

You see, ministering at the local abortion clinic certainly has many pitfalls. It can be hard, and it can be thankless and uncomfortable. It also can be dangerous and costly. But, though that be the case, ministering at your local abortion clinic ultimately brings glory and honor to God. Standing in front of the abortion clinic, day in and day out for nearly five years now, I have experienced the hatred of the world. But, more important, I have also experienced the pleasure of my good Father and have seen the fruit of faithfulness to Him. What a privilege it has been to herald the words of eternal life to a lost and dying culture. I have seen the gospel penetrate hard hearts and stop mocking mouths, bringing tears to eyes of those with whom God was dealing.

Trust Him and begin to love your pre-born neighbor as yourself by reaching out to their parents with the message of the gospel.
